BASIC INFORMATION

- Organizer:** The “Kids of Budapest 1956” Foundation
- Location:** Hungary / Budapest and Lakitelek
- Participants:** Czech, Polish, Hungarian, Slovak students
(10 students and two educators from each country)
- Lodging:** Internationally mixed - shared rooms, 3-4 students per room
- Food:** Daily breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided except on arrival and departure days. Special dietary needs should be indicated in advance.
- Transportation:** By rented bus for all group travel during the program.
- Group preparation:** Each student group comes with a prepared program in which they introduce the past, present, and future of their country, city, and school.
- Finances:** Lodging, food, transportation, and program participation will be paid by the Organizer.
- Clothing:** Appropriate hot summer clothing is recommended, including outfits for sport and swimming.
- Free time:** Program schedule allows for minimal free time away from the camp site. Spending money is based on individual needs.
- Internet access:** Wireless internet will be available on the camp site in Lakitelek.
- Insurance:** Individual travel insurance for foreign students is recommended.
- Language:** English is the official language of the camp, but there will be interpreters who speak the language of the participating countries.
